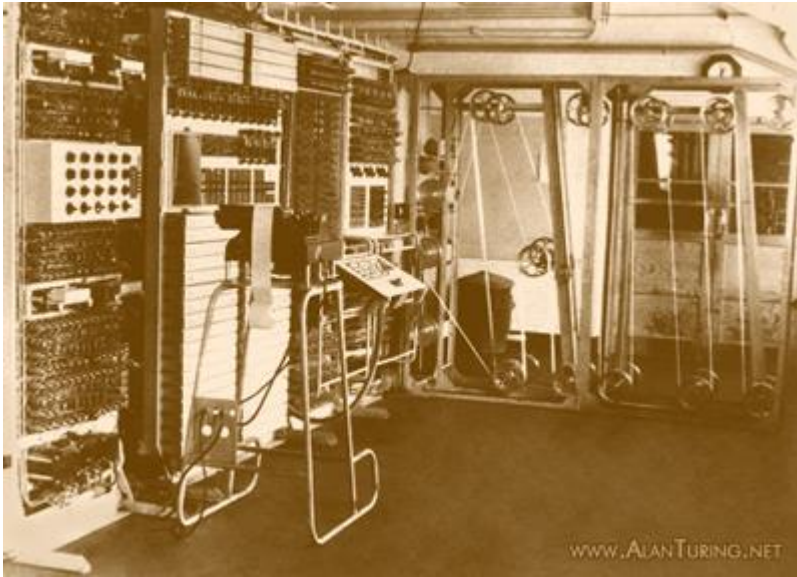


Computing: Code Breakers



For computing this week we would like you to become become code breakers by solving a series of codes related to the first verse of a poem by Roald Dahl.

You will need paper and a pencil no printing required!

Can you use your problem solving skills to crack the code?

Some of the words are in the wrong place. Can you rearrange your jumbled up code so it makes sense?

Hints: it is a rhyming verse.

The first line is correct. 1 = a, 26 = z

Remember it is about using your logical reasoning rather than simply 'knowing' the right answers. The journey, rather than the destination that is important.
